Only the latter two were implemented. Soon afterwards, European leaders were preparing their own institutions: the Council of Europe, founded in 1945, and the European Parliament. And a trilateral system of economic cooperation was created in 1947. Its three pillars were the European Coal and Steel Community, the European Economic Community, and the European Atomic Energy Community. To prevent this instability from occurring again, Euro was founded in 1999, and in 2000, a treaty to create the European Union entered into force. Many people view the EU as a political and institutional instrument of economic government. But it has one crucial limitation: it was set up as a non-sovereign federation, under the direct and immediate control of the member states. And the European Commission, its most important institution, works only for the European Council. If any one member state wishes to leave, it can. And if that state were to leave, the EU would collapse. But when Spain had to withdraw from the euro in 2001, the member states and the Commission did nothing to preserve the union. This could be seen as a missed opportunity, to be sure. But in the 15 years since this opportunity was missed, the costs of the euro crisis have been crippling the European economy. One might object, or perhaps even cynically argue, that a catastrophe like this isn't what the EU was built for. But that's a mistake. The problem is not that the Europeans want

Detailed Information about SNMP JManager: SNMP JManager is an SNMP tool based on the JMX (Java Management eXcape). For most web browsers and to work with SNMP JManager you need to install the java.sun.com/jmx/SNMP.jar file. Installation SNMP JManager: SNMP JManager is stored in the same directory you save the JAR file. SNMP JManager by default works on Linux distributions but it also works on Windows Starting SNMP JManager: In the Linux terminal window, go to the directory where JManager is stored, and execute the file that contains the class "java -classpath \*.jar net.JManager.main(args)". Alternatively, you can start it from the command line: snmp.jmanager.URL="/h2/snmp"; %java.command% -classpath \*snmp\*.jar net.JManager main(new String[] {"-url", "/h2/snmp", "-compression", "SNMP", "-port", strPortSnmp, "-timeout", strTimeoutSnmp, "-username", strUsernameSnmp, "-password", strPasswordSnmp}); JMX: The JMX interface is used to manage the operations that JManager will perform and to handle the exchange of information between the Java VM and the registered service. Once the SNMP JManager is started, the system execution is sent to a thread called "SNMP Manager", and the thread is represented by a state object. The object represents a SNMP Manager that will be registered in the JMX system. All the registration operations will execute in this thread, and when they are finished the system execution is sent to another thread (called "SNMP Thread") that is waiting to receive the work that the SNMP Manager handled in the previous thread.
